JUNIOR YEAR CHECKLIST


- COLLEGE SEARCH- gathering a list of schools that you are interested in learning more about
- COLLEGE VISITS (Virtual or On-Campus)
 - o helps you decide if the college offers the right environment for you SIGN UP AND TAKING THE SAT AND/OR ACT (SPRING 2025)
 - Build a resume (done during Junior Interviews and continue to update)
- Think about who you will ask to write you a letter of recommendation?
- Which teachers know you best as a learner/person/leader?

TRY TO FOCUS ON A LIST OF 5 TO 7 POTENTIAL COLLEGES

- 1-2 Reach Schools
 oShot for admission; your academics are below admission averages
 - 3-5 **50/50 Schools**oGood candidate; your academics are exactly within admission averages
- 1-2 Likely Schools
 oStrong candidate; your academics are above admission averages
 Be sure to have safe schools academically and financially on your list!



 Scores can lead to National Merit Scholarships (for 11th grade students)




KHAN ACADEMY PREPARING FOR THE SAT
